This festival traditionally celebrates the conclusion of the bountiful harvest season on the 15th day of the 8th lunar month when the moon appears to be the fullest and the brightest. Moon cakes are exchanged and the importance of family unity is reaffirmed. This is the reason why the Mid-Autumn Festival is the second most celebrated and important event in the Chinese culture, just next to the Chinese New Year. Historically, this festival commemorates the crafty 14th Century uprising of the Chinese Han rebels against the Mongolian occupation of China during the Yuen Dynasty (A.D. 1280-1368) when the rebels secretly organized an uprising by using the moon cakes to hide and pass along messages.
